



F1 Tomato Sweet 'n' Neat

An ultra compact variety available in bright yellow, scarlet and cherry red. Sweet 'n' Neat tomatoes are ideal for small pots and containers and will average around 60-80 fruits through the growing season, even on a windowsill. Grown in a larger container (16") Sweet 'n' Neat can produce over 200 fruit in a season.



F1 Tomato Megabite

A compact Tomato producing unusually large fruit for the size of plant. The first compact 'Beefsteak' variety available.



F1 Tomato Totem

Compact Tomato that will produce a mass of medium bright red fruit throughout the season. A very heavy cropping variety, Totem may need to be supported as the fruit matures to ensure the plant does not suffer with the weight of fruit.



F1 Tomato Little Sun Yellow

A neat companion to Totem. Slightly more compact and with bright yellow fruit. The bright yellow fruits contrast well with the green foliage, and provides a very good yield for a compact type.



Vegetalis Indeterminate Tomatoes

F1 Tomato Pink Charmer

An indeterminate variety with high yielding trusses and deep rosy pink fruit weighing ¾oz (20-25g). Very good flavor, with a 10% Brix rating and high yielding with up to 40 fruit per truss.



F1 Tomato Sugar Gloss

An indeterminate variety with high yielding trusses and very visually attractive glossy red fruits. The bright red cherry fruit weigh approximately ¾oz (20-25g). They also have a very good flavor with a 12% Brix rating. High yielding with up to 60 fruit on the long, elegant trusses.



F1 Tomato Apricot Dream

F1 Hybrid indeterminate variety with a mass of very sweet fruit in a delightful apricot/orange color. Apricot Dream will produce 20-30 fruit per truss with a very high Brix rating of 11.5 giving a candy-like sweetness! Indeterminate but with a controlled habit making it very useable in a patio container.

Vegetalis Determinate Tomato

F1 Tomato Big League

Big League a unique new determinate tomato with very large 14 - 21 oz (400-600g) beef steak fruits. Big League is perfect for a large patio container, reaching a final height of approximately 48" (120cm), and produces the largest fruit of any true container type to date. Because of the sheer weight of the fruit, Big League will require support.
